Reporting to the Recreation and Culture Coordinator and Recreation Programmer, the Lifeguard/Swim Instructor will be responsible for supervising and facilitating aquatic programming at Birdseye Pool.

The responsibilities of this position are as follows:

- Facilitate swimming lessons and recreational programs
- Observe pool patrons and ensure that pool rules and safety practices are followed
- Supervise entrances and exits
- Collect pool admission fees
- Assist with emergency procedures, complete paperwork, and communicate accidents and/or incidents to Recreation Coordinator or designate
- Maintain accurate inventory of supplies and equipment
- Collect daily attendance records
- Provide superior customer service skills
- Perform administrative duties
- Perform cleaning duties
- Understand and adhere to the Township of Scugog policies and procedures
- Be available between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.
- All other duties as assigned.

Qualifications and Skills:

- Candidates must be at least 16 years old and be enrolled in high school, or post-secondary education
- Possess and keep current Standard First Aid/CPR 'C'
- Hold current NLS and Lifesaving Society Swim Instructor certifications
- High Five Principles of Healthy Childhood Development would be considered an asset
- Strong customer service skills and ability to perform some administrative duties
- Provide a current Criminal Information Request prior to employment start date (applicants 18 years and older)
- Must be available to attend all days of paid training on:

 - Monday June 2 (3:30 to 8:00 PM)
 - Saturday June 7 (9:00 AM to 5:00 PM)
